- San Miguel County Evacuation Shelter is at Old Memorial Middle School (MMS), 947 Old National Road 505-429-0336.
- The Governor approved sheltering in state parks and waived the rate for those displaced by fire. Patrons show proof of address to the ranger to have the fee waived.
